Guidelines for Jurying Process:

All perspective ACG Student Artists are required to present their artwork for review and acceptance to our Gallery Screening Committee. Their collective decision will be final.

All submissions must be accompanied by a short bio about the student.

Art submitted must be in a professional manner. No unframed or unfinished art will be accepted for review, except for work intended to be displayed without a frame.

Acceptance of Student Artists will be based on execution, craftsmanship, aesthetic quality and originality

Art presented for jurying must be representative of what you plan to display in the gallery. If selling prints or giclées of your work (photos are considered prints) you are required to have at least one original for sale on the wall. If showing photographs, you must be the original photographer.

When submitting works for more that one category, clearly indicate which pieces are intended for which category.

A minimum of five pieces must be submitted for review. Additional pieces may be presented.

All applicants, approved or denied, are notified upon completion of the Screening Committee review.

Please Note:

If accepted, the Marketing Committee may take still photographs of your artwork an may ask to film you creating your art at your studio or at the Gallery for advertising purposes.
